3) Should the approved person receive any credible and/or scientifically proven information EN that indicates any adverse effect of DAS-59122-7 corn, the National Biosafety Board authority shall be informed immediately (for a review as in Section 18 of the Biosafety Act).

4) Any spillage (during loading/unloading) shall be collected and cleaned up immediately.5) Transportation of the consignment from the port of entry to any destination within the country shall be in secured and closed containers.
